- Pre-registration Ends on 1 PM on the Thursday before the parade
- **An additional fee of \$10 is applied for late registration.**
- **Registrations accepted morning of the parade up to 9:30 AM**
- **Entry Fee & Insurance:** Send with your entry form **This is a MUST not a request**

Drivers of all moving vehicles (including trucks pulling floats) are required to show proof of insurance. Mail a copy of insurance card or Certificate of insurance with your entry form.

- On the form, please include some interesting facts about your entry for the announcer to read as you pass the judge's platform. Please limit your comments to 20 words or less.
- **Parade Staging:** The Wheatridge Middle School Parking Lot at 8:30 A.M.
- **Horse staging area:** Use the field to the west of the Brown Building. Keep the horses in this area until 11:00 AM or when instructed to move forward.
- **Pick-up your number** at the Registration Table by the Brown Building as you enter the staging area from Madison Street. Do not enter staging area from the south.
- Your Number must be on the front right side of your entry. Example: Outside of the windshield on the passenger side** horse & rider- number on the front of the rider right side** Imagine you are a judge or announcer sitting on the stand, can your number be seen easily?
- ▶ **Registration ends at 9:30 A.M. sharp** The parade starts promptly at 10:30 A.M.
- Follow the directions of the parade line-up committee on the morning of the parade.
- **Do not throw anything to the spectators. This practice has caused serious injury and death at other parades.**

The Cash awards & ribbons will be given out at the Fair Office on the Fairgrounds after 2:00 P.M. the day of the parade and must be picked up before 1 PM on the Sunday following the parade.
